Qualities required getting success in Placement

Finding a good job after graduation has become very difficult these days. There is an over saturation of the job market because of increase in number of graduates passing out each year. In this situation, campus placements are like a boon for engineering graduates. Using this, students may land with a decent job provided and also students should have very important skills such as – English proficiency and Communication Skills, Learning behavior and Oral presentation.

Your chances of success at the interview, determines your career whereby getting a good break at campus eases the way ahead. Here are some of the key qualities which will help you to achieve success in campus placement process. Also, if any one lacks of these qualities, work on it and improve the skills.

1. Confidence : The first few minutes of the interview is what matters the most. To get maximum gain from the interview one should be confident. Confidence is the most important thing that will help students to go a long way in campus placement process where the interviewing panel looks for this quality in candidates. Being confident will help you to clear different stages of placement process much more efficiently. The confidence levels can be improved when you are well prepared. Preparation includes – brushing up your technical knowledge, preparing your updated resume, good etiquette, body language.
2. Enthusiasm: An important skill where the interviewing panel will be noticing and rating. Special attention must be given to the mood and self appearance during the interview. This has to be showed by proving your Quick learning abilities, “Never say Never” attitude, finding creative solutions.
3. Interpersonal and Communication Skills:
Possessing good communication skills is an added advantage for many job seekers these days, since it is a quality that all organizations seek. Being able to communicate in a way that is comprehensible by any person(s) in an enterprise is extremely crucial, since it can make business pursuits.

By observing others - making a conscious effort to understand how communication occurs - you will think about how you communicate and be more aware of the messages you share. This provides a perfect opportunity for you to develop your interpersonal communication skills. Good colleges have programs dedicated towards polishing soft skills of its students. If a student has been hard working right from the start of his education, they won't feel the problem to get placement.

4. Team Player :

Interviewers value candidates who are team players. Such candidates will make the process of inter departmental coordination much more efficient in their company. This skill can be showcased using your coordination and team working skills during your group discussion stage. A team player is a person who “Demonstrates Reliability, Communicates constructively, Listens actively, Functions as an active participant, Shares openly and willingly, co-operates and pitches in to help, Exhibits Flexibility, Shows commitment to the team, Problem solving approach, Compromises His Point Of View”.

5. Leadership:

Being a team player is good. You will get noticed by the interviewers. But being a leader is a different thing altogether! Leadership skills will help you achieve greatness in your career. Companies value leaders. Displaying leadership quality during campus placement stage such as group discussion will surely help you get noticed by the interviewers.

6. Honest:

Be honest while answering personal questions asked by the panel. Don't try to make up facts just to create a good impression. It will be possible that the panel may dig deep into the matter and ask more questions related to that topic, thus making you uneasy and uncomfortable. Also, instead of creating a good impression it will only pull you back.

The only other quality one should have is “How you present yourself”

Apart from the above tips, try to do some mock selection processes and analyze the below points while you are doing.

1. The way you speak and respond matters a lot. Behavior
2. The way you solve or answer with premium knowledge on the topic. Fastness
3. The way you say NO to the unknown answers. Your tactics
4. The way you deal with the pressure. Smile
5. Your presence of mind. Attitude

Seriously after all this we can say preparing for campus placement is not an easy task. I think it is an art...LOL...But on a serious note you have to prepare well for any interview for your own confidence as getting job or opportunity is a different thing and giving your 100% with technique is a different thing which is very important for your confidence.
