

RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY

(4) MEMBERSHIP:

/

Any Alumni, students of the **ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF DHANEKULA INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY**, who has completed any degree in the institution is eligible to become a member of the Society. Enrolment of member shall be the sole discretion of executive body. Every person whose application for membership is accepted by executive body shall pay the membership fees.

(5) SUBSCRIPTION:

Every member has to pay Rs.100/- as annual subscription at the beginning of the every year. If it is not paid within three months of the commencement of the year, such member shall forfeit the membership and will not have any right to exercise the Vote.

(6) **GENERAL BODY MEETING:**

The General Body Meeting shall be conducted every year in the month of April but in special circumstances it may be conduct any time of necessary. The General quorum for the General Body Meeting shall be $1/3^{rd}$ of the members. The General Body can modify the rules of the society subject to the provision of the societies registration Act 35/2001.

(7) GENERAL BODY AND ITS FUNCTIONS:

- a) To elect the members of Governing Body and Office bearers once in 2 years or when majority of the members resign from Governing Body membership.
- b) To receive and approve the annual report of society and audited statement of accounts.
- c) To appoint an Auditor.
- d) To approve legal Advisor, if necessary.
- e) To approve the budget for the ensuring year.

6 To consider amendments to Roles & Regulations

g) To consider or decide any matter which may be brought before the meeting with permission of the President. The Quorum for General Bods shall be 1. 3rd of members of the society.

 The quotine of the Executive Body meeting shall be 2/3rd of the members

(8) THE EXECUTIVE BODY:

The Executive body should consists of a President. Vice President. Secretary, Treasurer and Executive Members 3. The Executive Committee shall piect once in six months. It must scrutinize the financial position of the society. The Quorum for it shall be 2. 3° of the members. The members of the Managing Committee shall be elected at a General Body. Meeting: On completion of the term of two years, executive body vacates the office and fresh executive body shall be appointed by members in General body meeting. However for any reason fresh general body is not elected after completion of Term of two years, then the existing body shall continue to hold the office of executive body till new body is elected.

(9) THE GOVERNING BODY FUNCTION:

- To oversee the affairs of the projects/project, programs implemented by the society
- 2. To accept donations, gifts, etc., from any source and seek to any rightful means to raise funds for the society.
- 3. Children Homes
- Caring poor students and helping them in and giving eduction. Technical and Non Technical Education.
- 5. Helping to the oldage people and widows.
- To undertake any type of project or programme for the welfare of the society.
- 7. To consider amendments to Rules & Regulations.
- To enable the alumni to participate in activities, which would contribute to the general development of the Institute.
- 9. Medical support to the poor.
- 10. Orphanages Centres in India and Vocational centres.
- 11. To promoting advancement of Education and literacy by helping children to go to school.

- 12. To develop Social, Cultural and Economical Standards of the members of the Society
- 13. To eradicate social Evils of the society-
- 14. Career guidance and councelling for youth.
- 15. To keep the alumni abreast of scentific and technological developments of national importance.
- 16. To help the alumni with their technical problems.
- 17. To Institute prizes and scholarships, and render financial aid to deserving students of the Institute.
- 18. To contribute towards the welfare of the alumni

(10) DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

PRESIDENT:

The President shall preside over the executive committee and the General Body and special Meetings of the Association.

The President has all Powers related to Open and Maintenance of Bank Account/s and Cheque power.

The President has all powers to maintain the Committee and also the President has all the rights to discharge the duties of Treasurer.

In the absence of President the said power will be given to one of the Vice President.

He shall have the Casting Vote in case of a tie on any issue put to vote either by show of hands or by secret ballot.

He shall oversee the functioning of the office Bearers and Sub-Committees, if any of the association in General.

VICE PRESIDENT:

One of the Vice-President shall preside over the Meetings of the General Body or Committee in the absence of the President. The two Vice-Presidents shall assist the President in the discharge of his duties and shall exercise all or any of the powers delegated to them by the President.

SECRETARY:

He is the Chief executive of the association. He shall be the person vested with the authority to sue or be sued in court of law in respect of any dispute or disputes concerning the Association; further he is authorized to delegate this authority to any person nominated by him as he may deem fit in the best interests of the Association.

He shall maintain a Roster of Members showing their age on the date of admission, addresses, telephone numbers and other particulars which

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would help identification of the members without difficulty, issue or cause to issue notices in respect of executive Committee Meetings and Ordinary/Extraordinary/Special General Body Meetings.

He shall maintain Minutes Books - one for the executive Committee Meetings and the other for the General Body Meetings (Ordinary, Extraordinary or Special) and record the proceedings thereof after they have been approved by the members and obtain the signature of the President He shall also maintain an Attendance Register to know who have attended and who are active members and to permit them to vote, active members alone being eligible to vote.

He shall scrupulously implement the decisions of the Executive Committee and the General Body:

He shall prepare and submit to the Executive Committee the Annual Reports and get them ratified by the General Body at its Annual General Body Meeting:

He shall jointly operate the Bank account/s along with the Treasurer. The President may sign the cheques in the absences of the Secretary, but the signature of the Treasurer is compulsory in either case;

He shall be the corresponding officer of the Association.

He shall maintain or cause to maintain the following books for the Association: Cash Book, Ledger, Minutes Book, Receipts, Vouchers and all other relevant records.

TREASURER:

He shall receive all payments, issue receipts and deposit them in the approved banks as hereinafter provided. He shall be responsible to maintain the books of account in the form acceptable to statutory authorities. He shall submit the statements of Account to the Executive Committiee for its approval and get them approved by the General Body at its annual meeting.

He shall get the accounts audited.

He shall meet and account for such expenditure as is properly vouchered and incurred either by himself or by the President or the General Secretary as the case may be from time to time from the imprest cash maintained by him.

He shall deposit moneys received in the bank or banks duly approved by the Executive Committee by way of a Resolution recorded in Minutes ANN Book.

PRESIDENT

The executive committee has to do the duties entrusted to them for time to time as per the occasion demands.

EXECUTIVE MEMBERS:

They are the responsible persons to attend to such activities of the Society that the Executive Committee entrusts to them.

(11) FUNDS:

To carryout the objects of the society, funds will be raised by donations, gifts and other offerings as may be determined by the Executive Committee

The funds of the society shall be spent for the attainment of the objectives of the society and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to any of its members through any means. Funds of the society should be deposited in a Schedule Bank in the name of the society and bank account be operate by Secretary and Treasurer jointly. The President may sign the cheques in the absence of The Secretary. The funds of the society shall be invested in accordance with the provisions of section 13(1)(d) r.w.s 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

AUDIT: (12)

The account of the society shall be audited by the qualified Chartered Accountant and the financial year of the society shall be **April 1**st to March 31st.

AMENDMENTS: (13)

No amendment or alteration shall be made to the Bye-laws of Society unless it is voted by **3/5th** of the members present for the purpose and the amendment shall be made with the Prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax, having jurisdiction over the society.

WINDING UP: (14)

If the General Body feels that it is necessary to wind up the Association after thoroughly examining all aspects, it can adopt a resolution to dissolve the Association. The assets etc., of the Association shall be transferred to another association having similar aims and objects and having registration with Income Tax department under section 12A and Section 80G. The assets of the Association shall, under no circumstances, be shared or apportioned or appropriated among the members 3/5th members windup.

PRESIDENT

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LEGAL PROCEEDINGS / SUITS: The society may sue or be sued in the name of the President /Secretary as per provisions laid down by the Andhra Pradesh societies Registration Act,2001.

DISSOLUTION: The society shall not be dissolved unless two-third of its (16)members shall have expressed such a wish for such dissolution by their vote delivered in person at a General Meeting convened for the purpose.

If on such dissolution of of the society there shall remain after satisfaction all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, shall be dealt within the accordance with the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh socieites Registration Act, 35/2001.

LIQUIDATION: (17)

All the legal affairs of the society movable and immovable properties shall be settled U/s 26 of the societies Registration Act, in the district court.

DISPUTES: (18)

In the event of any dispute arising among the committee of the members of society. In respect of any matter relating to the affairs of the society. Any member the society may proceed with the dispute under the provisions as mentioned in Andhra Pradesh societies Registration Act, $\left(U\right/$ s 23) and the legal advise whenever in necessary.
